What

Fellowship volunteers prepare and serve refreshments.

Number of Volunteers

One volunteer can easily setup, serve refreshments and cleanup afterwards. Additional volunteers may assist with this activity, especially by visiting with members of the congregation, visitors and guests.

Additional Responsibilities

None.

Before Worship Service

- Setup and preparation of coffee, water and cups, as time permits.

During Service

- Brew several pots of coffee if not already started before worship service.
- Setup and preparation of water, optional refreshments or treats.

After Service

- Serve refreshments and optional items.
- Provide hospitality and Christian fellowship.
- Cleanup as required.

Additional Notes

- Use good hand-washing practices. You are handling food.
- The normal schedule for fellowship is after the 8AM worship service and up to the start of the 10:30 AM worship services. When there is just one worship service, fellowship time is after worship service for about 30 minutes.
- Coffee machine and brewing instructions are located in the kitchen near the coffee machine and supplies.
- Fellowship refreshments may be simply coffee and water. Optional refreshments may include juice, cookies, bars, breads, etc. as desired.
- Ask your Ministry Team Leader or Assistants if you have any questions about the location of kitchen items or operation of the coffee machine.
- Used washcloths, drying towels, etc. should be hung up to dry when you are finished. The Kitchen Supervisor for the month will launder them.
